


Did you know everyone's fingerprint is unique? Even twins have different fingerprints! Allah pays attention to every detail, even our fingerprints.

OG Mountains as Pegs

Mountains are humongous and really tall! Mount Everest, the tallest one, is almost 8.8 kilometers high! But did you know it has roots that go even deeper—about 200 kilometers! The Quran mentioned this fact long before scientists discovered it. How amazing is that?

The water in the Atlantic Ocean is different from the water in the Mediterranean Sea. They have a big invisible wall between them, stopping them from mixing! The Quran talked about this many years ago.

"And He made a barrier between them, stopping them from mixing." Surah Furqan 25:53



 The Dead Sea is not actually a sea but a saltwater lake.

2. It is one of the saltiest bodies of water on Earth, with almost 10 times more salt than ordinary seawater.

3 The Dead Sea is the lowest point on Earth, sitting at around 430 meters below sea level.

The water of the Dead Sea is so salty that it makes swimming in it very difficult.

5. The mud from the Dead Sea is rich in minerals and is believed to have medicinal properties.

Spherical Shape of the Earth



"And after that He spread the Earth." Surah Naziat 79:30

"He created the heavens and Earth in truth. He wraps the night over the day and wraps the day over the night and has subjected the sun and the moon, each running [its course] for a specified term. Unquestionably, He is the Exalted in Might, the Perpetual Forgiver." Surah Zumar 39:5

10 Rotation of the Sun

Long ago, scientists thought that the Earth was at the center and everything in the sky like the Sun and the stars moved around it. Then, they learnt that the Sun was at the center of our solar system, and that planets go around the Sun, while also spinning around themselves.

We now know that our Earth spins on its axis causing day and night. The Earth also goes around the Sun, which gives us our year and different seasons. But guess what?

The Quran actually told us all of this almost 1400 years ago!

Create Your Own Solar System Model

Let's make a model to understand how the sun, Earth, and moon are related. You'll need:

•Styrofoam balls (1 large for the sun, 1 small for the Earth, and 1 more small one for the moon) – if you don't have it you can use cardboard.

Paint or markers
Craft sticks or toothpicks
Glue or tape

Here's what you do:

1.Paint the styrofoam balls to look like the sun, Earth, and moon.

2.Attach the large ball (sun) to a surface.

3.Attach the small ball (Earth) to a craft stick and place it at a distance from the sun that reflects the real scale. 4.Attach the smallest ball (moon) to another craft stick and place it closer to the Earth.

That's it! You've created your own solar system model.




Did you know that almost all the water on Earth is salty? We can't use or drink salt water! Only 3% of earth's water is fresh, sweet water. But guess what? We have a special system that helps replenish our freshwater, so it doesn't run out.

And you know what's even more amazing? The Qur'an actually told us about these facts a long time ago, way before we discovered them recently!

As they approached, a flock of birds came flying through the sky and dropped pebbles on the enemy's army. These pebbles turned into fiery rocks and scared away the elephants, saving the Kaaba from destruction.



Elephants communicate in a variety of ways, including trumpet calls, body language, touch, scent and vibration.



Pretend you are the hoopoe bird speaking to Prophet Sulayman (alayhi salaam). What would you say?



> The surah also talks about people who forget to thank Allah for all the good things they have. It reminds us to be grateful for what we have and to use our blessings wisely.





15 The Men In The Cave

The story of the men in the cave is mentioned in Surah Kahf (the 18th chapter) of the Quran. It tells us about a group of young men who believed in and worshipped the One True God - Allah.

"[Mention] when the youths retreated to the cave and said, 'Our Lord, grant us from Yourself mercy and prepare for us from our affair right guidance."" (Surah Kahf, 18:10)

Many years ago, during a time when people were worshipping idols and made up gods, these young men decided to stay true to their belief in Allah. They didn't want to follow the wrong path and worship idols. Because of their faith, they faced challenges and were treated badly by others. So, they sought shelter in a cave. Allah put them into a deep sleep, and they remained asleep for many years. While they were sleeping, Allah protected them from harm.

When they woke up, the world had changed a lot. The people in the town nearby had started to believe in Allah, just like the young men did. People knew about the young men and their story.

The story of the men in the cave teaches us the importance of staying firm in our beliefs, even when it's difficult. It shows us that Allah can protect and take care of us, even in challenging times.

Did you know that honeybees are like nature's superheroes, helping plants grow by carrying pollen from flower to flower.

2. Honey is a sweet treat that bees make. It's even sweeter than sugar! Did you know that there are different colors of honey? Some are light and some are dark. In Surah An-Nahl, Allah says, "There comes forth from within it a fluid of varying colors, wherein is healing for mankind." (Quran 16:69).

3 Bees are amazing flyers! They can zoom through the air at speeds of up to 15 miles per hour. That's faster than many of us can run!

Gees have been around for a really long time, even before the dinosaurs! They've been buzzing around for about 30 million years, helping plants and making honey.

5. To make just one pound of honey, bees have to visit about 2 million flowers! That's like going on a flower treasure hunt. Talk about hard work!







6 Honey isn't just yummy, it's also good for you. It gives bees lots of energy, and it's packed with antioxidants that can help keep us healthy too.


7. Boys bees are called drones, and did you know that they don't have stingers? Only girl bees, called worker bees, have stingers to protect their hive.


The Story of the Whale


Interesting Facts

The Miraculous She-Camel and Prophet Saleh (alayhi salaam)

In the Quran, the story of the she-camel and Prophet Saleh (alayhi salaam) is mentioned as a sign from Allah to the people of Thamud. The people of Thamud were a prosperous civilization but refused to worship Allah.

Prophet Saleh (alayhi salaam) was sent by Allah as a messenger to guide the people of Thamud. He warned them about Allah's punishment and asked them to worship Allah alone. As a miraculous sign, Allah allowed Prophet Saleh (alayhi salaam) to bring forth a she-camel from a rock in the mountains! The she-camel was unique and extraordinary. It was tall and beautiful. Prophet Saleh (alayhi salaam) instructed the Thamud people to treat this she-camel with respect and not to harm her. However, these people ignored Prophet Saleh's (alayhi salaam) message. Some men decided to kill the she-camel. As a result, Allah sent a severe punishment upon the disbelieving people.


Let's make a cool camel using your handprints!

Prophet Ibrahim (alayhi salaam) was a devoted prophet of Allah who faced numerous challenges throughout his life. When the people of his city saw that he was not worshipping their idols, they decided to throw him into a huge blazing fire!

When Ibrahim (alayhi salaam) was thrown into the huge pit of fire, Allah commanded the fire to become cool and peaceful for him.



The scorching flames turned into a source of comfort and peace, ensuring that Ibrahim (alayhi salaam) was unharmed.

Allah said, **"O fire, be coolness and safety upon Ibrahim." (Surah al Anbiya, 21:69)**

This astonishing event shows us the power and protection Allah gives to those who place their complete trust in Him.





One of the remarkable miracles attributed to Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) is the splitting of the moon.

This event is mentioned in the Qur'an in Surah Al-Qamar (Chapter 54), verses 1-3, which states,

"The Hour has come near, and the moon has split."

> Upon the request of the people of his time, Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) pointed towards the moon and it miraculously split into two distinct halves. After a period of time, the moon was then brought back together.

ACTIVITY Make Your Moon

To create a cotton ball moon painting, you will need the following materials:

- Paper plate or white cardstock
- Cotton balls
- Paint (dark grey, light grey, light purple, and white)
- Clothespin
- Paintbrush
- Glue (optional)
- Construction paper or black cardstock (optional)

Let's make a cotton ball moon painting! Here's how:

1.Get your materials ready. Use a paper plate as your canvas or cut white cardstock into a circle for the moon shape.

2.Attach a cotton ball to a clothespin to use as your paintbrush.

3.Dab dark grey paint on the canvas to create the moon's texture using the cotton ball.

4.Layer light grey paint over the dark grey areas, leaving some spaces untouched for depth.

5.Use a new cotton ball to dab light purple paint on the moon for color.

6.If you want, add drops of white paint to create highlights.

7.Let the paint dry. You can even add a background using construction paper. And there you have it - your very own cotton ball moon painting!

The Alternation of Day And Night

In the Qur'an, the creation of day and night is mentioned as one of the signs of Allah's power and wisdom.

"And to Allah belongs the dominion of the Heaven and Earth, and Allah is over all things. Indeed, in the creation of the heavens and earth, and the alternation of the night and the day are signs for those of understanding." [3:189-190]


Rain From the Sky

Different Types of Fruits and Vegetables


The Qur'an also describes the beauty and diversity of fruits and vegetables, with Surah Al-An'am 6:141 stating:

This verse talks about the different fruits and vegetables that Allah has created and how important they are for us to eat. It also reminds us to be generous and help others.





In Surah Ash-Shu'ara, verse 63, Allah says: **"So We inspired to Musa, 'Strike the sea with** your staff.' And it parted, and each portion was like a great towering mountain."

When Musa (alayhi salaam) and the Children of Israel were being pursued by Firawn and his army, they reached the shore of the sea. There was no way to escape. Then, Allah commanded Musa (alayhi salaam) to strike the sea with his staff. Musa (alayhi salaam) struck the sea with his staff. The sea miraculously parted, creating a path through the water. Each side of the sea stood tall like massive mountains, allowing Musa (alayhi salaam) and the Children of Israel to walk safely on dry land. They crossed the sea, escaping Firawn's army.


Surah Masad is the only place in the Qur'an that talks about one of the enemies of Islam mentioned by name.

Abu Lahab was the uncle of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). He was the only uncle who openly didn't like him.

Once, the Prophet (peace be upon him) gathered everyone and he said he has an important message to tell them. He (peace be upon him) asked his people to worship Allah and follow Islam. This made Abu Lahab angry because he cared a lot about money, was proud, and worshipped idols. He didn't like what his nephew said and angrily said, "May you perish! You gathered us only for this reason?" Then, a special part of the Qur'an, Surah Lahab, was sent down. It said Abu Lahab and his wife would go to Hell forever because of their bad actions and believing in idols.

30 A River in Paradise!

Surah Al-Kawthar is the shortest surah in the Qur'an. This surah means "abundance" or "goodness".

The surah was revealed to Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) during a time when he had lost his two sons and was being teased by the pagans of Makkah. It was a time of sadness, but Allah revealed this surah to comfort and encourage him.

Did you know? "Al-Kawthar is a river in Paradise whose banks are of gold and it runs over pearls. Its water is whiter than milk and sweeter than honey". (At-Tirmidhi)
